How we use your information

We use your information to:

- Communicate with you about your register of interest and application
- Process your application
- Arrange interviews
- Complete PVG checks
- Enrol you on the course

Our lawful basis for using this information is **contract** and **public task.** Where we are using criminal conviction information to carry out the relevant PVG checks, our lawful basis is **legal obligation** under the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007.

Sharing your information

Your information will be shared with:

- Providor, as the employment partner for this course. The information shared will be to enable interviews to be carried out and share course outcomes.
- Disclosure Scotland, for the purposes of completing PVG checks.

Retention

Your information is retained for 6 years after you leave the college as part of your student records.
