- To provide access to college systems and buildings

Our lawful basis for using this information is legitimate interests.

To provide a safe working environment

Our lawful basis for using this information is legal obligation.

Where we process special category data, our additional lawful basis is reasons of substantial public interest, under the Equality Act 2010: DPA 2018, Schedule 1, Part2 8 (1) – Equality or opportunity of treatment.

Failure to Provide Information

If you do not provide personal information that is required by NCL to provide a placement opportunity we may not be able to provide you with the placement you have applied for or commenced.
