Performing Manufacturing Operations

100 Word Overview

This Scottish Vocational Qualification (SVQ) is intended for those in the manufacturing sector and allows candidates to demonstrate competence in job-related skills in their area of work and expertise including promoting effective working relationships and controlling manufacturing operations. Skills and knowledge based evidence will be gathered in the workplace and will be based on national occupational standards, which the learner must meet to be competent in a particular task. It is ideal for individuals working in manufacturing looking to develop their skills and potential and obtain a nationally recognised qualification.

Objectives of the Programme
