Social Media

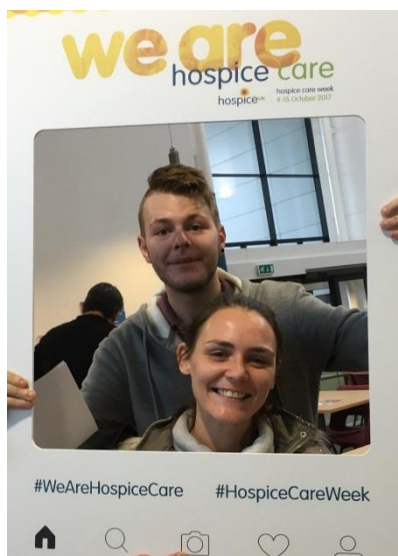
Students engaging with our SA Social Media are continuing to rise with our followers increasing to 15011 at the time of writing this report.
