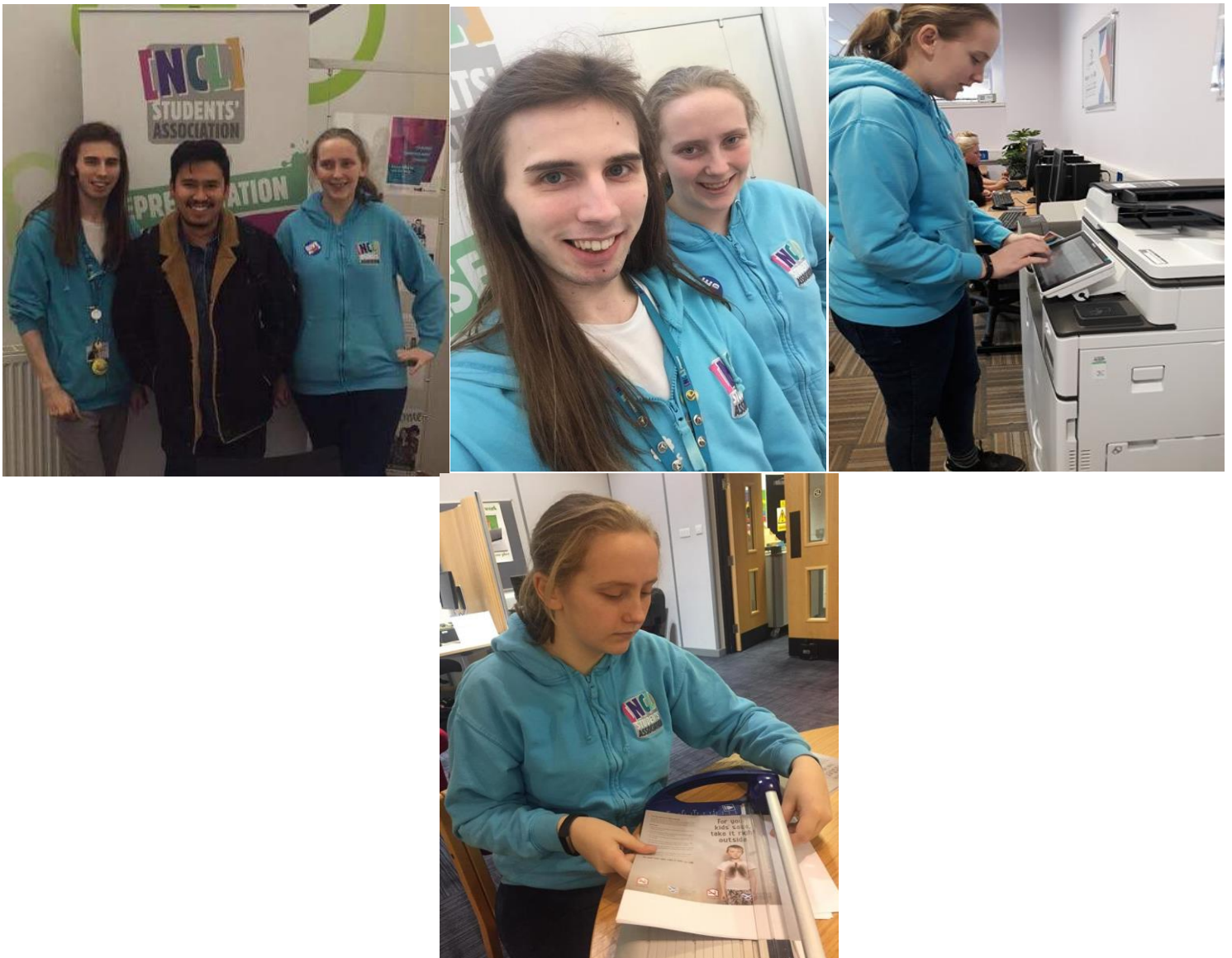


## Work Experience.

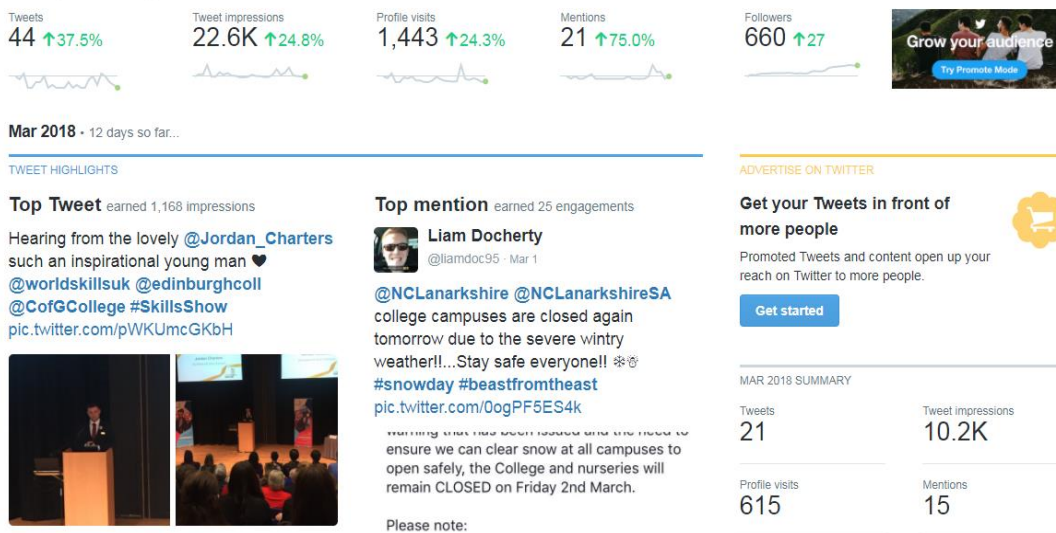
The Event was held on 7<sup>th</sup> March at City Campus.



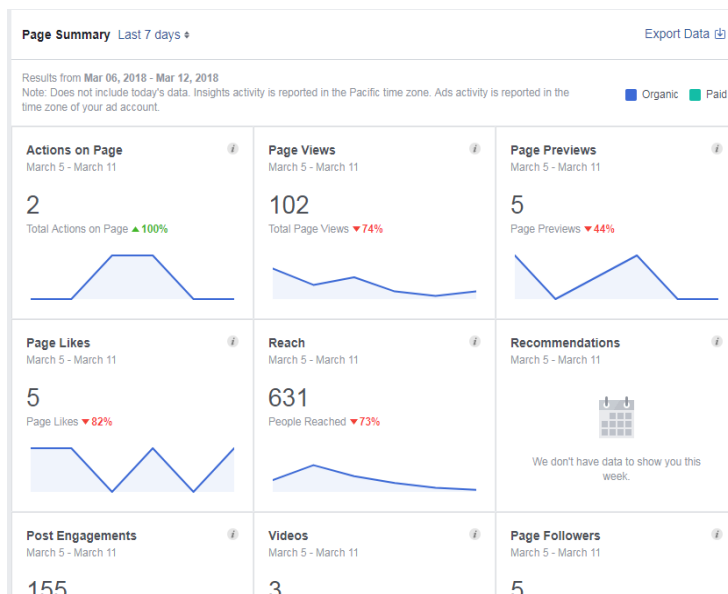
# Social Media
