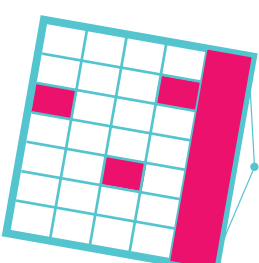

- Three Campuses celebrated LGBT History Month in February with student feedback collected and shared in an online story.



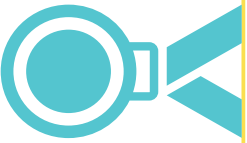
STUDENT AMBASSADORS

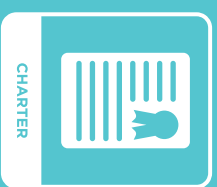
- Class rep and ambassador training to be delivered in May - organised by Be Engaged
