How we use your personal data

We will use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To book travel and accommodation
- To ensure appropriate insurance is in place
- To arrange work placements
- To support you on placement
- To contact your emergency contacts, when necessary
- To monitor compliance with the participation agreement and college code of conduct
- To allow the college to claim funding for the project
- To make subsistence payments to you
- Reporting to funding providers, including equality monitoring

Our lawful basis for using this information is **contract**. Where special category data is processed our lawful basis is **substantial public task**, for the purposes of equality monitoring and insurance.

Retention
