1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This paper provides information on the published report of the Scottish Funding Council - College Leaver Destinations 2022-23. College Leaver Destinations 2022-23 - Scottish Funding Council

2. COLLEGE LEAVER DESTINATION PERFORMANCE

- 2.1 The publication College Leaver Destinations (CLD) 2022-23 reports on the destinations of leavers from full time courses 3-6 months after qualifying. Data collation for this report began in February 2024 and continued to October 2025 with linkage and matching of leavers' destinations to two additional datasets: Skills Development Scotland (SDS) and the Students Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS); however, this is restricted to 16- to 24-year-olds only due to current legislative limitations. Key national highlights within the report include:
 - The number of Sector Leavers with a confirmed destination 14301, was the lowest of the
 last 8 sessions. This is consistent with statistics on college student numbers as published in
 the College Statistics publication which has shown a reduction in the numbers of students at
 college College Statistics 2023-24 Scottish Funding Council
 - For 2022-23, destinations for 89.0% of full-time qualifiers was confirmed. Of the 39.2% with known destinations were sector leavers, with the other 60.8% continuing their study at college. Of those that were sector leavers, 86.7% went onto positive destinations. This was a 0.7% increase from 2021-2022.
 - In 2022-23, 86.7% of Sector Leavers found a positive destination, which was up from 86% in 2021-2022.
 - Unemployment and unavailability for work for sector leavers decreased to 13.3% from 14% in 2021-2022.
- 2.2 A summary New College Lanarkshire CLD performance is in Section 3 Tables 1 4
- 2.3 Qualifier destination confirmation rate for New College Lanarkshire increased from 82.9% to 86% in 2022-23. This is 2% above the national average.
- 2.4 The confirmed positive destination for New College Lanarkshire of 95.2% is 0.4% above the national average and a slight increase on positive destinations reported in 2021-22 when the return was 94.5%.
- 2.5 New College Lanarkshire has well-established progression routes for students to further study which at 77.4 % in 2022 -23, is up from 74.7% in 2021 22. New College Lanarkshire is is 1.6% above the national average for progression to further study.
- 2.6 Unemployment rate for 2022-23 New College Lanarkshire leavers is 3.4%, which is up from 3.1% in 2021 23, and is now above the national average of 3.2%.
