How we use your personal data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To confirm your reservation and communicate with you in relation to your reservation
- To contact you to discuss dietary requirements
- To process your payment
- To ask for your feedback on your experience

Our lawful basis for using this data is **contract** and **public task**.

- To send you direct marketing via email
- To promote the training restaurants and hospitality department via our social media channels.

Our lawful basis for using this data is **consent**.

Sharing your personal data

We do not share your data with any third parties.

Where you have consented to your photo being used to promote the training restaurants via our social media platforms, your image will be publicly available.

Retention

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, audit, or reporting requirements.

- Reservation details - will be retained until the end of the academic year that you attended the restaurant.
- Consent to marketing – will be retained until the end of the academic year that you withdraw your consent.
