How we use your information

We use your information:

- To administrate and deliver the No One Left Behind Programme.
- To manage your employability journey
- To provide access to college systems and services.
- To access funding to support the costs of the No One Left Behind Programme.
- To support the Scottish Government and Local Authorities to monitor how funded local employability support services are being implemented.

Our lawful basis for using this information is contract and public task.

Where we process special category data, our additional lawful basis is reasons of substantial public interest, under the Equality Act 2010: DPA 2018, Schedule 1, Part2 8 (1) – Equality or opportunity of treatment. As the placement will be provided by the NHS, it is necessary for us to ask if you have any criminal convictions, to allow us make sure that you are not barred from this type of work and meet the legal obligations under Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007.

Failure to Provide Information

If you do not provide personal information that is required by NCL for a contract or to fulfil our public task, NCL may be prevented from complying with our legal obligations and may not be able to provide you with the course for which you have applied or enrolled. In some cases, this could have an effect on your continued studies with us or lead to the withdrawal of any offer of study made.

Retention

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, audit, or reporting requirements.

We will retain your records for 5 years from the academic year that you complete the programme.
