How we use your personal data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

- To record your attendance and performance during your placement
- To provide access to college systems and buildings

Our lawful basis for using this information is **legitimate interests**.

- To provide a safe working environment

Our lawful basis for using this information is **legal obligation**.

Where we process special category data, our additional lawful basis is reasons of substantial public interest, under the Equality Act 2010: DPA 2018, Schedule 1, Part 2 8 (1) – Equality or opportunity of treatment.

Failure to provide personal data

If you do not provide personal data that is required by NCL to provide a placement opportunity, we may not be able to provide you with the placement you have applied for or commenced.

Sharing your personal data

We will share your personal data with:

Retention

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, audit, or reporting requirements.

Placement Applications: within one month of decision.

Placement Records: we will retain your records for 1 year from the end of your placement.
