How we use your personal data

We use your personal data for the following purposes:

Our lawful basis for continuing students is **public task**. For subscribers who register their interest at an event or via one of our recruitment forms our lawful basis is **consent**.

Sharing your personal data

We do not share your data with any third parties.

Retention

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, audit, or reporting requirements.
